The room was mainly decorated with flowers on the candelabras and on the top table; chair covers and a fairy light curtain were provided by the Culloden. As the room had been recently renovated there was no need for anything else.

Where was the Wedding Dress from?

Clíodhna allowed her mum pick the first bridal shop to look in which was The Wedding Studio at Katriona's in Banbridge. We went in and the girls were so helpful, I tried on 7 or 8 dresses that day and came across one which was very similar to the first dress I had marked in a bridal magazine;
