Vespers

Vespers is a sunset evening prayer service. The word is derived from the Greek η ("hespera") and the Latin vesper, meaning "evening". In the "Antiphony of Bangor", a manuscript from the 6th century written at Bangor Abbey, Vespers are called hora incensi. This name is interesting to note as the hora incensi recalls the custom of burning incense and lighting candles at the beginning of the evening. This ceremony of the lights at Vespers was very symbolic and the most solemn office of the day. It was an occasion. We trust that your dinner is an occasion also and an enjoyable one. Cene Bene.
